THE LOCATION



Australia's largest flat panel photovoltaic solar installation is at UQ St Lucia in Brisbane, Queensland. More than 5000 polycrystalline silicon solar panels are spread across four building roofs, covering a space equivalent to one-and-a-half rugby fields. A 6 x 7 metre 8.4 kilowatt CPV tracking array has also been placed near the carparks to research other solar power technology.
